AT&T's latest quick messaging phones come equipped with AT&T's new att.net mobile browser, which brings full Web browsing to feature phones. It provides three windows to the Web. From the homepage, users can browse the global Internet as well as assign bookmarks and shortcuts or set other preferences so they have quick access to their favorite content. A second window gives users location-aware local news and weather; one-click results for nearby restaurants, nightlife venues, ATMs and other points of interest; and access to maps, driving directions and traffic information.
