Preparations for the event have been ongoing and include both permanent and temporary network enhancements to handle what is certain to be unprecedented levels of voice and data use. AT&T employees are working hard to ensure that the thousands who are expected to descend upon the Tampa Bay area get the level of quality services they've come to expect from us.

As part of the drive to deliver the nation's best mobile Internet experience, AT&T has made nearly 575 wireless network upgrades in the Tampa Bay area since the beginning of 2011.

Enhancements through June 29, 2012 include:

4GLTE

Launched 4G LTE service, the fastest available mobile Internet technology, in the Tampa Bay area on Feb. 15, 2012.

more than 4.00 extra layers of frequency

- Adding capacity or an extra layer of frequency to cell sites like adding lanes to a highway with the addition of more than 400 of these layers, or "carriers." This increased capacity means faster downloads and fewer dropped calls for convention goers.
- 3 New cell sites or towers
- Activating three new cell sites or towers to help improve network coverage.

1,500 miles of Internet service

Ensuring wireless Internet service in hotels and convention venues throughout the Tampa Bay Region. This includes more than 85 locations covering more than 1,500 square miles.

10 temporary cellsites

Deploying as many as 10 temporary cell sites on wheels (COWs) to improve coverage and capacity at key locations within the Tampa Bay area.

200-I-Wi-Fi Hotspots

Plus, more than 200 AT&T Wi-Fi Hotspots are available throughout the Tampa Bay area.
