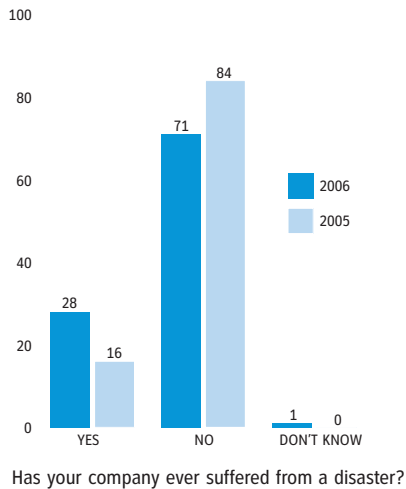


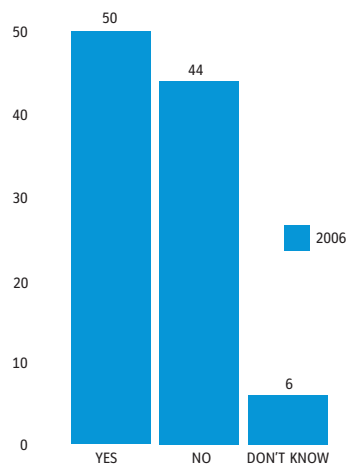

National Results Highlights

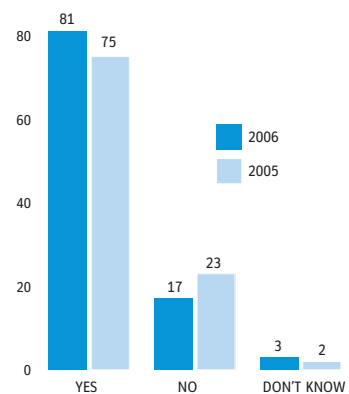


More Than 25 Percent of U.S. Companies Are Unprepared for Man-Made or Natural Disasters

- Nearly 30 percent of those surveyed said that their company has suffered from a disaster.
- Approximately half of the 1,000 companies polled said that they do not take specific protective actions even when state or federal governments issue warnings for an impending disaster.
- 81 percent of executives surveyed say that cyber security is part of their overall business continuity plan in 2006, up from 75 percent in 2005.
