AT&T Video Share is a unique groundbreaking 3G service that enables users to share live video over wireless phones while carrying on a voice call. Users can allow others to “see what I see, when I see it,” and the service provides a dramatic new way to share personal moments and key events beyond the capabilities of voice and text. Video Share provides users with a new level of connectivity and presents new opportunities to share experiences with friends and family across town or across the country. Consumers can now share moments with family and friends while the moments are happening — everything from weddings and a baby’s first steps to a Little League at-bat or a clearance-sale find.

For business users, the service enables a range of innovative business applications, from showing real estate or retail displays to facilitating insurance claims or troubleshooting efforts.

AT&T is the first U.S. service provider to deliver Video Share capabilities, which demonstrate the company’s powerful network and commitment to meaningful innovation. Video Share works exclusively on AT&T’s 3G wireless network, which is currently available in more than 300 markets, with continued expansion planned throughout 2008.

The service is the first AT&T application to use the company’s emerging IP Multimedia Subsystem-based network platform.

Service Requirements

To use Video Share, both the sender and receiver must have:

- > A 3G Video Share-capable wireless phone.
- > Video Share service enabled on the phone.
- > AT&T 3G wireless network coverage.
- > A “Video Share Ready” prompt when a call is placed.

Video Share minutes charged only to sender. For both the Video Share service packages and pay-per-use option, both sender and receiver will be charged for any airtime usage and wireless minutes.
