WHAT IS IT?

Wireless fidelity (Wi-Fi) connectivity typically takes place through access points, or “hot spots,” that use unregulated frequencies in the same spectrum as appliances such as microwaves and most cordless home phones. Wi-Fi access can be set up in homes, offices, airports, hotels, restaurants and other public facilities, providing a convenient way for connecting to the Internet or a corporate network or for accessing e-mail by using a wireless device.
