

Re: Notice to offer Supplemental Alternative Regulation Plan (SARP)

Dear «Contact_Name»:

As a signatory to the Oklahoma 271 Interconnection Agreement (O2A) with SWBT, SWBT is notifying you of an opportunity to amend your O2A with the Supplemental Alternative Regulation Plan (SARP). The SARP will provide you with the lowest offered rates for certain unbundled network elements.

If you amend your O2A with the SARP within a 30 day period (beginning on July 16, 2001 and ending on August 15, 2001), SWBT will: 1) provide you with a credit representing the difference between the prices that you have paid for unbundled network elements under the O2A and the prices for those same unbundled network elements that are contained in the SARP retroactively back to the effective date of CLEC's original O2A adoption or January 10, 2001, whichever is later; and 2) apply the prices in the SARP to your current embedded base of unbundled network elements on a going forward basis. Instructions for placing orders under the SARP are available on CLEC Online at <https://clec.sbc.com>.

In order to obtain the true-up described in item 1 in the paragraph above, you must request the SARP through the CLEC Online website at <https://clec.sbc.com> by August 15, 2001 at 5:00 p.m. CST.
