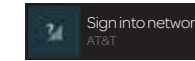

How to Connect to the AT&T Mobile Broadband Network

Enjoy the power of AT&T's 4G mobile broadband network as soon as you turn on your Nexus 7; just follow these simple steps to get connected fast.

1. With the device off, insert the SIM provided if it has not been previously inserted. Detailed instructions can be found in the Nexus 7 Quick Start Guide inside the Nexus 7 box.
2. Turn on the device and complete the on-screen setup. This requires a Wi-Fi connection. You will see "Setup Complete" when you are finished with this step.
3. When you are ready to activate your AT&T mobile broadband service, you will need a debit card, credit card or an existing account to (re)activate service.
4. To activate, swipe down from the top right corner of the display (from the clock and battery status indicator) and touch **Settings**. In the "Wireless & Networks" section, touch **More...** and then touch **Manage mobile plan**.
5. Google Chrome will open and present a secure AT&T Data-Connect tab. Select that tab and follow the prompts to purchase your preferred AT&T data plan. *If you are activating on an existing post-paid account, the primary cellular number for that account will be requested. If needed, the IMEI # can be found on the white label on the Nexus 7 box. The ICCID # is located on the AT&T SIM card holder.*
6. Once complete, you will receive an e-mail confirming that your service has started.
7. If at any time you do not have a Wi-Fi connection and your AT&T plan is inactive, you may also receive an indicator  on the left side of the notification bar at the top of your display. To activate service, touch the indicator and drag down.

You will see your list of notifications. Touch Sign into network



and continue with Step 5.

How to Manage Your Data Usage

To manage your account, change your plan or check your data usage, swipe down from the top right corner of the display (from the clock and battery status indicator) and touch **Settings**. In the "Wireless & Networks" section, touch **More...** and then touch **Manage mobile plan**. Sign in using the credentials provided in Step 5 above. Once you are logged in, touch **My Device and Plans** and then touch the device name used in Step 5 above (e.g. Device 1). Scroll down to see your current plan and data usage. If your plan has expired, touch **Manage your Data** to purchase a new plan. *You can also manually navigate to <https://buyasession.att.com> from any PC.*

To check on-device estimated data usage, swipe down from the top right corner of the display (from the clock and battery status indicator) and touch **Settings**. In the "Wireless & Networks" section, touch **Data Usage**.

Note: Actual billed usage can be higher than the estimated data usage displayed. For example, actual billed usage can be higher when you travel internationally or outside of the AT&T network, or when you use a SIM card with another device. On-device usage display is not a 1:1 reflection of actual AT&T data usage. Your data use is estimated by Google, not AT&T.
