



## AT&T Wi-Fi Milestones

**1999** The term Wi-Fi first commercially used and the Wi-Fi Alliance is founded

**April 2004** Free SBC Wi-Fi at SBC Park, home of the San Francisco Giants

**June 2004** SBC Wi-Fi available in 6,000 McDonald's restaurants nationwide

October 2004 SBC Wi-Fi available for \$1.99 a month

**November 2004** SBC Wi-Fi available in more than 600 Barnes & Noble stores nationwide

**2004** First Wi-Fi certified handset and television set entered the market

May 2005 SBC Wi-Fi available in California State Parks

**October 2005** Merriam-Webster adds "Wi-Fi" to the dictionary

**2005** First Wi-Fi certified gaming device and digital still camera entered the market

May 2006 AT&T expands Wi-Fi access to more than 10,000 Wi-Fi Hot Spot locations throughout Europe

March 2007 AT&T premiere Wi-Fi subscribers can access more than 48,000 Wi-Fi Hot Spots worldwide

**July 2007** Free AT&T Wi-Fi access available for higher-speed AT&T broadband customers

**August 2007** AT&T adds access to an additional 9,000 Wi-Fi Hot Spots across Europe

**September 2007** First Wi-Fi enabled Blackberry is available from AT&T

**January 2008** Free AT&T Wi-Fi access for more than 10 million AT&T broadband customers

**February 2008** AT&T Wi-Fi and Starbucks announce agreement to provide Wi-Fi access at Starbucks stores nationwide

May 2008 Free AT&T Wi-Fi access for LaptopConnect customers

October 2008 Free AT&T Wi-Fi access for iPhone and Blackberry customers

November 2008 AT&T acquires Wayport

**December 2008** 20 million AT&T Wi-Fi connections made in all of 2008

2008 Nearly 70 million Wi-Fi enabled handsets sold

June 2009 20 million AT&T Wi-Fi connections reached in the first half of 2009 (20.5 million)

**June 2009** AT&T supports auto-authentication on iPhone OS 3.0

**July 2009** Barnes & Noble offers free AT&T Wi-Fi at its stores nationwide

**August 2009** AT&T expands global Wi-Fi access to 125,000 Hot Spots

**September 2009** 20 million AT&T Wi-Fi connections reached in 3Q 2009 (25.4 million)

**December 2009** More than 85 million AT&T Wi-Fi connections handled in 2009

**January 2010** 20 million AT&T Wi-Fi connections reached in just the first five weeks of 2010

**January 2010** McDonald's offers free AT&T Wi-Fi in more than 11,000 restaurants nationwide

May 2010 AT&T launches pilot Wi-Fi hotzone project in Times Square

**July 2010** Starbucks offers free AT&T Wi-Fi at its locations nationwide

**July 2010** AT&T and Hilton Worldwide enter agreement to enhance Wi-Fi and Internet services in more than 3,200 hotels

July 2010 Survey finds that 43 percent of people who own Wi-Fi enabled smartphones use Wi-Fi daily [Kineto Wireless]

**July 2010** AT&T expands its Wi-Fi hotzone pilot project to Charlotte, N.C.

**August 2010** AT&T expands Wi-Fi hotzone pilot project to Chicago

**December 2010** Following successful pilot, AT&T launches major Wi-Fi initiative to deploy more hotzones in key markets
