


AT&T's 4G Evolution

We have two 4G networks working together for customers: LTE and HSPA+ with enhanced backhaul. We're expanding 4G LTE across our network footprint, and AT&T customers will continue to have access to fast 4G speeds even when they are outside of an LTE area. With other carriers, when you travel outside of their LTE coverage, you're on a much slower 3G network.
