Quick Tips



WATCH LIVE TV.

To **start recording** a program that you are watching, press the **RECORD** button on the remote control.

To schedule a recording using the program guide, navigate to the program and then press the **RECORD** button. A red circle will appear next to the program title. To **stop a recording**, press the **RECORD** button.

⏮ ⏪ Use these to pause, replay, and fast forward recorded programs. Also, use to pause and replay live TV.

Use the **DVR** button to access your recorded programs.

Caller ID will automatically pop up on your TV screen when you receive a telephone call.

Requires subscription to AT&T caller ID service.



WATCH MOVIES & MORE.

Press the **HOME** button and select *Movies* for access to movies, TV shows, music videos and more!

To **search the entire catalog of downloads**, select *Search All* from the Movies & More Main Menu.

To **browse the movie catalog**, select *Categories*, then *Movielink Movies* from the Movies & More menu.

Once you have selected a program, movie or music video to download, you will add it to your My Downloads queue by using the **on-screen activity key** labeled *Download*. If the downloaded item you select has a rental fee, it will appear next to the title. Downloaded items will not incur charges until they are viewed. Download time varies depending on your high speed Internet connection, but you may begin viewing while downloading, once a buffer has been created.

To **watch a downloaded item**:

1. Select My Downloads from the Movies & More Main Menu.
2. Choose the download you wish to watch and press the **activity key** labeled *Watch* or *Rent*. If the download has not created enough buffer, the orange activity key will not be labeled and the download is not available to watch yet.
3. Press the **activity key** to view the status of the download.

To **view movie showtimes at theaters** in your neighborhood:

1. Select *Movie Showtimes* from the Movies & More main menu.
2. Select *Local Theaters*.
3. Select the desired theater and movie to view showtimes.



VIEW PHOTOS.

Upload photos from your camera directly to your Homezone.

1. Press the **HOME** button and select *Photos*.
2. Select *Import Photos*.
3. Plug the USB cord of your digital camera into the front panel of the Homezone receiver and select *Continue*.
4. The photos will be transferred from your camera and stored as Rolls in your Photo Library.

View photos from your AT&T Yahoo! Account.

1. Press the **HOME** button and select *Photos*.
2. Select AT&T Yahoo! Photos.
3. Your photo albums will load.
4. Select the desired folder by pressing **OK** on the remote to view.

To upload music to the receiver from a computer, please review the MediaScout section below.



LISTEN TO MUSIC.

Listen to Yahoo! LAUNCHCast streaming Internet radio by selecting it from the Music menu.

You can **listen to music** 3 ways:

1. On the SIRIUS music channels (6001-6116).
2. Using AT&T Yahoo! LAUNCHCast streaming radio, accessible through the Music menu.
3. Moving your purchased music from your networked PCs to the Homezone receiver using MediaScout and selecting these tracks from the Music menu.

To upload music to the receiver from a computer, please review the MediaScout section below.



MEDIASCOUT FOR AT&T HOMEZONE.

With MediaScout for AT&T Homezone, you can upload digital photos and music stored on your computer to the receiver. Please be aware the computer must be connected to your home network.

To begin, simply install the software on the enclosed disc. Additionally, the software may be downloaded from www.att.com/homezone/mediascout.

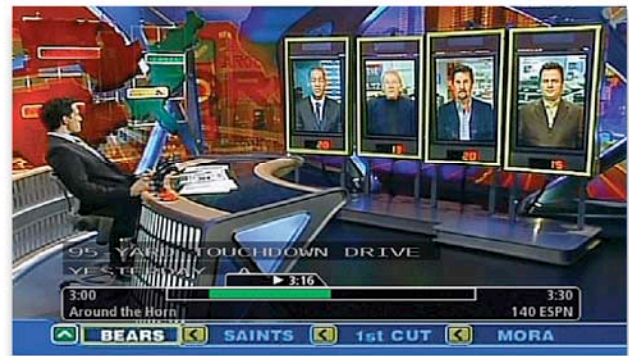
Watch Television Your Way

With the DVR, you can pause and replay live TV. Better yet, schedule a one-time recording using your DVR, or select Series Subscription to make sure you never miss another episode.

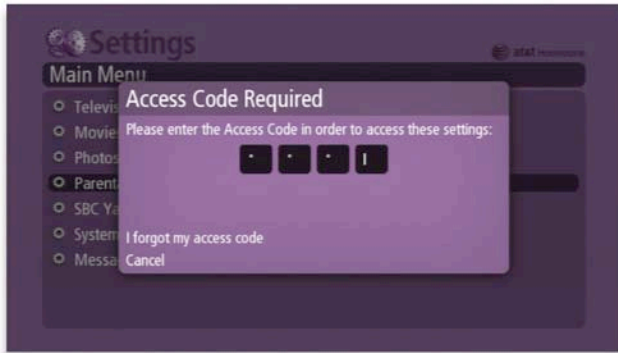

Frequently Asked Questions

Receiver & Remote Control

I AM HAVING TROUBLE WITH MY AT&T HOMEZONE RECEIVER. WHAT CAN I DO?

- 1 Unplug your receiver from the power outlet for 30 seconds, and then plug it back in.
- 2 Make sure that all of the wire connections on the back of your receiver are tight.
- 3 Update your AT&T Homezone receiver's software by pressing the  button on your remote control to put your receiver in standby mode for 20 minutes.
- 4 Call the support number, listed in the back of this guide, for more technical help.

HOW DO I ACCESS AT&T HOMEZONE SPECIAL FEATURES, LIKE MOVIES AND PHOTOS?

Homezone special features may be accessed by pressing  HOME on the remote control, and selecting the colored activity key associated with the desired feature.

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT TO KEEP MY PHONE LINE PLUGGED INTO MY AT&T HOMEZONE RECEIVER?

The phone line allows you to order pay-per-view programming from your television screen, preventing some additional programming fees. Also, if your AT&T phone service plan includes caller ID, you can see incoming caller information displayed on your television screen.

HOW DOES AT&T HOMEZONE USE THE AT&T YAHOO! HIGH SPEED INTERNET CONNECTION?


Your AT&T Yahoo! High Speed Internet connection gives you high speed access to Movies & More—a library of more than 10,000 movies, TV shows, short films, music videos and more, which you can download and rent for playback right on your television. Also, your high speed Internet connection allows you to view online AT&T Yahoo! Photo albums, listen to AT&T Yahoo! LAUNCHcast streaming digital radio stations, and browse AT&T Yahoo! Movie Showtimes listings.

Your receiver's Internet connection also allows you to schedule DVR recordings and movie downloads and enjoy your photo collection when you're away from home, using AT&T Yahoo! Web Remote for Homezone.

HOW MANY TELEVISIONS DOES MY AT&T HOMEZONE RECEIVER SUPPORT?

Your AT&T Homezone receiver can simultaneously support one high definition and one standard definition television with access to your recorded programs, movies, photos and music collections from either TV. Your second TV receives its signal through your household's coaxial cable wiring.

WHAT IS STANDBY MODE, AND WHY DO I NEED TO USE IT?

The green light on the front of your receiver indicates your receiver is in Active Mode and ready for use. You can press the Standby  button on your TV1 and TV2 remote controls to put your TV1 and TV2 tuners into Standby Mode. Standby Mode frees up system resources, but doesn't actually turn the receiver off. Any recordings or downloads you have scheduled will continue.

HOW DOES THE TV2 REMOTE CONTROL WORK?

The TV2 remote can control the Homezone receiver from up to 200 feet away—even through walls.

CAN I CONTROL OTHER EQUIPMENT WITH MY REMOTE CONTROL?

Your TV1 and TV2 remotes can be programmed to control the power, volume and muting of devices like your TV and surround-sound system. Refer to the Quick Installation Guide included with your AT&T Homezone receiver for instructions.

Installation & Setup

WHY IS THE INTERNET LIGHT ON THE FRONT PANEL OF MY AT&T HOMEZONE RECEIVER NOT ILLUMINATED?

A solid non-illuminated Internet light indicates that your AT&T Homezone receiver is not communicating with your AT&T Wireless gateway. Please connect the wireless adapter included in the kit and navigate to Settings, select System Configuration, select Network Information. Press the orange activity key and follow the on-screen menu.

Frequently Asked Questions

WHY IS THE INTERNET LIGHT ON THE FRONT PANEL OF MY AT&T HOMEZONE RECEIVER BLINKING?

A blinking blue light indicates that you have not yet entered your AT&T Yahoo member ID and password. To enter your ID, navigate to Settings, select System Configuration, select AT&T Yahoo! Account. Press **OK** to enter your information.

WHAT SHOULD I DO IF MY HIGH SPEED INTERNET SERVICE HAS NOT BEEN INSTALLED?

In some cases, your satellite television service may have been installed before your high speed Internet service. When AT&T Yahoo! High Speed Internet service and your AT&T Wireless Gateway are installed, your receiver will automatically initiate the setup flow and help you activate your Internet-enabled Homezone services. You can also access the Internet setup by selecting one of the Internet-enabled features such as AT&T Yahoo! Movie Showtimes, AT&T Yahoo! LAUNCHcast radio, or AT&T Yahoo! Photos.

HOW DO I CONNECT MY RECEIVER TO MY WIRELESS NETWORK?

Connecting to your wireless home network is easy. You will need the serial number and wireless key from the bottom of your AT&T Wireless Gateway. Then access the Settings menu, select System, Network Configuration, and Reconfigure Network. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the wireless setup.

WHAT IF I SKIPPED ENTRY OF MY AT&T YAHOO! MEMBER ID AND PASSWORD?

Your AT&T Yahoo! Member ID is necessary to enable exciting features like Movies & More, AT&T Yahoo! Movie Showtimes, AT&T Yahoo! LAUNCHcast radio, and AT&T Yahoo! Photos. Your AT&T Yahoo! ID also enables access to Homezone services over the Internet using AT&T Yahoo! Web Remote for Homezone. Enter your ID at any time by going to the System Settings menu.

Remember that your AT&T Yahoo! Member ID is your master account's email address. Subaccount IDs will not work, and using someone else's AT&T Yahoo! Member ID may create billing issues, so be sure to only enter your AT&T Yahoo! master account ID. Call your regional support number, listed in the back of this guide, if you have forgotten your ID or password.

TV & DVR

WHERE CAN I FIND A LIST OF CHANNELS?

Within a few days, you will receive an AT&T DISH Network welcome kit in the mail. This kit includes a channel lineup card. You can also find channel lineup info online at www.att.com/homezone.

HOW DO I SET UP A CUSTOM GUIDE?

Create a custom guide of channels by selecting the Manage Guides activity key while viewing the Program Guide and following the on-screen instructions.

HOW DO I FIND PROGRAMS TO WATCH OR RECORD?

In addition to browsing the Program Guide, you can search for specific programs by selecting the Search Program Guide activity key while viewing the Program Guide.

HOW DO I RECORD PROGRAMS?

Press the RECORD button on the remote control or select the Record activity key to record programs directly from the program guide or while watching Live TV. Additional recording options allow you to record single shows or all instances of a program, select whether reruns will be recorded, and adjust recording start and finish times.

HOW CAN I CONFIRM MY SCHEDULED RECORDINGS?

You can view all scheduled upcoming recordings from the TV menu under Scheduled Recordings.

WHAT CAN I DO WITH MY RECORDINGS?

You can view, sort or delete items from your library of recorded shows by selecting My Recordings from the TV menu, or by selecting the MY RECS button on the remote control. Once your library is full, the oldest programs will automatically be deleted to make room for new recordings. You can protect a program from deletion by selecting the 'Protect' option.

HOW MANY PROGRAMS CAN I RECORD, WATCH OR PLAY AT THE SAME TIME?

You can record a maximum of two programs and watch two DVR recordings (one on TV1 and one on TV2) at the same time. If you try to record an additional program, on-screen instructions will allow you to choose which programs to record.

HOW WILL I BE BILLED FOR PAY-PER-VIEW?

DISH Network Pay-Per-View charges appear on the AT&T | DISH Network portion of your AT&T bill. You can review your charges by visiting Home/System/Messages/Purchase History within the Homezone on-screen experience.

WHAT DO PARENTAL CONTROLS DO?

You can use Parental Controls to remove channels from the Program Guide, require a password to rent content or access programs, or even hide all adult content from the on-screen experience. See the *Parental Controls* topic for more information.

WHAT FEATURES CAN I USE WHILE AWAY FROM HOME?

You can browse your Program Guides, schedule DVR recordings and manage your library of recorded shows remotely over the Internet using AT&T Yahoo! Web Remote for Homezone. Refer to the *Web Remote* topic for more information.

Movies & More

HOW DO I DOWNLOAD SELECTIONS FROM THE MOVIES LIBRARY?

To download movies, TV shows and more, your receiver will need to be connected to your home network and you'll need to have entered your AT&T Yahoo! Member ID (email address) and password. For more information, see the *Installation & Setup* topic.

HOW DOES DOWNLOAD MANAGEMENT WORK?

AT&T Homezone downloads titles one at a time until the Movies & More hard drive space is full. You can delete old titles to make space for new ones.

WHEN CAN I BEGIN WATCHING THE TITLE?

When a sufficient portion of the title is downloaded, you can begin playback. The amount of time this takes is dependent upon the speed of your high speed Internet connection. For faster downloads, try to minimize downloading of other large files on PCs connected to your home network.

WHEN AM I CHARGED THE RENTAL FEE?

A rental charge is applied once you begin playback of the title. Once you've started playback, you can watch the title as many times as you like during the rental period.

HOW WILL I BE BILLED FOR RENTALS?

Rental charges for Internet-downloaded movies appear on the AT&T Internet Services portion of your AT&T bill. You can keep track of your rental charges at the Money Clip account management website at <https://mtbselfcare.sbcis.sbc.com/>. Use your AT&T Yahoo! member ID (email address) and password to log in.

WHY ARE TITLES NOT ALWAYS AVAILABLE?

There are often restrictions on the period of time during which a title can be downloaded. Once this period, which usually lasts several months for newer titles, has ended for a specific title, AT&T Homezone may no longer offer that title for download. If a title is in your My Downloads list when this availability period ends, it will be listed as 'No Longer Available.'

HOW MANY DOWNLOADED MOVIES OR SHOWS CAN I WATCH AT ONE TIME?

Your AT&T Homezone receiver allows you to watch one downloaded title at a time on either TV1 or TV2. If you're watching a downloaded title on one TV and wish to watch a downloaded program on the other TV, you'll have to stop playback of the title on the first TV. (Note that this limitation does not apply to DVR or live television programs.)

WHY DO SOME MOVIES LOOK STRETCHED?

Movies that look 'stretched' are caused by widescreen movies being re-sized to fill a standard-definition TV screen. To correct this, press the **#/ASPECT RATIO** button on your remote control. This will adjust the picture on your TV screen.



Frequently Asked Questions

WHY ARE FAST FORWARD, REPLAY, SKIP AND RESUME SOMETIMES UNAVAILABLE?

Once a sufficient portion of a movie has downloaded you can rent the movie and start watching. However, Fast-forward, Replay, and Skip commands will be unavailable until the downloading is complete. If you stop watching a movie while it's still downloading, you can't resume from where you left off—you must restart from the beginning.

CAN I MANAGE MOVIES DOWNLOADS FROM OUTSIDE THE HOME?

You can browse the Movies library, schedule downloads and manage downloaded titles remotely over the Internet using AT&T Yahoo! Web Remote for Homezone. Refer to the *Web Remote* topic for more information.

CAN I USE AT&T HOMEZONE TO VIEW MOVIE SHOWTIMES?

The AT&T Yahoo! Movie Showtimes section provides info and showtime listings for current theatrical releases. You'll find top box office listings, user ratings and more, all provided by AT&T Yahoo! Movies. If you've established a list of favorite theaters using your AT&T Yahoo! profile online at <http://movies.yahoo.com>, you can display these theaters in your AT&T Homezone on-screen experience.

Music

HOW DO I USE AT&T HOMEZONE TO ORGANIZE MY MUSIC COLLECTION?

Use the MediaScout™ for AT&T Homezone software downloaded at www.att.com/homezone/mediascout or located on the enclosed CD to copy music from the PCs on your home network to your AT&T Homezone receiver. Music stored on the receiver may be accessed using your TV and organized into playlists.

CAN I USE AT&T HOMEZONE TO LISTEN TO STREAMING INTERNET RADIO?

AT&T Homezone allows you to listen to high-quality AT&T Yahoo! LAUNCHcast streaming digital radio, including the customized station you can set up at <http://music.yahoo.com>.

Photos

HOW DO I TRANSFER PHOTOS FROM MY DIGITAL CAMERA TO MY AT&T HOMEZONE RECEIVER?

Plug your digital camera into your receiver's front-panel USB port. Use the 'Import Photos' command from within the Photos section to upload the photos from the memory card to your receiver.

HOW CAN I TRANSFER PHOTOS FROM PCS ON MY HOME NETWORK?

Use the MediaScout™ for AT&T Homezone software downloaded at www.att.com/homezone/mediascout or located on the enclosed CD to copy photos from the PCs on your home network to your AT&T Homezone receiver.

HOW DO I USE AT&T HOMEZONE TO ORGANIZE MY HOME PHOTO COLLECTION?

Once photos are uploaded to your AT&T Homezone receiver, they are organized into Rolls. You may then create Albums and populate them with photos from your Rolls. Albums can be viewed on the TV manually or as a slideshow.

HOW DOES AT&T HOMEZONE INTEGRATE WITH YAHOO! PHOTOS?

If you have entered your AT&T Yahoo! Member ID and password during Setup or within the Settings Menu, you can view your AT&T Yahoo! Photos online albums right on your television. Web Remote

HOW DO I ACCESS MY HOMEZONE RECEIVER REMOTELY?

View your Program Guide, schedule and manage DVR recordings and movie downloads, and even browse your photo library from anywhere you have a broadband Internet connection. Simply use a broadband-connected PC to visit your AT&T Yahoo! High Speed Internet homepage at <http://att.yahoo.com> and look for the AT&T Yahoo! Web Remote for Homezone navigation module.

HOW CAN I MANUALLY ADD THE WEB REMOTE MODULE TO MY HOMEPAGE?

In some cases, the Web Remote module may not automatically appear on your AT&T Yahoo! custom homepage. If this is the case, log into your homepage at <http://att.yahoo.com>, click on the 'Add Content' link, search for 'Homezone' using the 'Find Content' tool, and click on the 'Add' button. You can then use the 'Change Layout' controls to move the module to the desired location on your custom homepage.

CAN I USE MY CELLULAR PHONE TO ACCESS MY HOMEZONE RECEIVER?

Parental Controls

HOW DO PARENTAL CONTROLS WORK?

AT&T Homezone includes full-featured Parental Controls to help manage your family's television-viewing experience. You may establish password access based on industry standard ratings, lock individual channels, or even remove all references to adult content.

HOW DO CONTENT CONTROLS WORK?

Content Controls allow you to block access to programs and downloads based on the content ratings. Select the highest allowable level of unrestricted access to TV programming. When viewers attempt to watch a program or download content that exceeds the permitted rating, they will be asked to enter the access code.

HOW DO CHANNEL LOCKS WORK?

Channel Locks allow you to lock individual channels so that household members need to enter an access code before they can get to the restricted channel. To enable Channel Locks and setup your access code, select Parental Controls from the Settings menu.

HOW DOES HIDE ADULT WORK?

Hide Adult blocks the content description of adult PPV movies (above an MPAA rating of 'R') within the Program Guide. You can also block access to these programs (and other adult-oriented shows or movies) by rating. See the above *How Do Content Controls Work* question for more information.

HOW DO PURCHASE CONTROLS WORK?

You can restrict online purchases by requiring that an access code be entered before a financial transaction takes place, such as renting a movie or ordering pay-per-view. To set up this feature, select Purchase Controls from the Settings Main Menu.

Caller ID

HOW DOES CALLER ID WORK?

If your AT&T telephone service includes Caller ID, you'll see the caller's number and name (if available) on your television when the phone rings. You can dismiss the notification by pressing OK on the remote control. If desired, you can turn this feature off in the Settings Menu. Additionally, a Caller ID Log is available in the Settings Menu, under the Messages option.
