Before you begin

A. Wait until 8 p.m. on your service activation date (see packing slip)

B. Unpack your kit

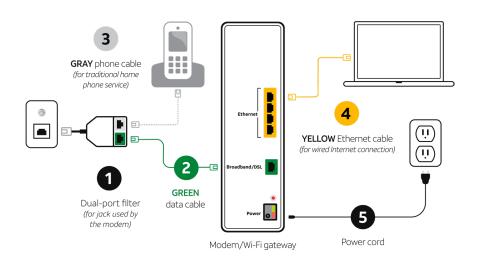

Have your DSL Account Number or your telephone number and your primary AT&T email address (Member ID) ready, if you have one.

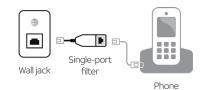
1 Connect Your Modem/Wi-Fi Gateway



Once connected, wait about 15 minutes for your modem/Wi-Fi gateway to power up.

2 Install Filters

Install single-port filters for any other jacks with phone or fax.



3 Activate & Register

- A Turn off security or firewall software (or give permission to allow the network connection when prompted).
- B Open your browser and follow the prompts. To start the online registration process, go to att.net/activate

During registration, you will need to:

- Enter your AT&T DSL Account Number or your telephone number
- Create an AT&T email address (Member ID) and password OR enter an existing one
- Turn your security or firewall software back on (if you turned it off).

4 Update Settings

After registration, **update your modem/Wi-Fi gateway setting** to your AT&T email address and DSL Network Password.

NOTE: Your **DSL Network Password** is used by your modem/Wi-Fi gateway to connect to the DSL Network. This is different from your AT&T Account Password.

Check modem/Wi-Fi gateway settings

Steps to configure your modem/Wi-Fi gateway settings. Devices vary considerably, so please consult the user quide for your device.

A Enter your modem/Wi-Fi gateway's IP address into your Internet browser

Your IP address (as well as any required username and password) should be listed in the modem/Wi-Fi gateway's user guide or labeled on the bottom of the modem/Wi-Fi gateway.

B Enter settings in the configuration screen

The configuration screen may appear automatically, or you may need to select Advanced. Enter the following information in the appropriate fields (order and terminology may vary).

If your modem/Wi-Fi gateway does not support onboard PPPoE, you will need to configure your computer for PPPoE instead.

Troubleshooting

Check your connections

- Make sure cables click tight
- If you still can't connect to Internet, try another phone jack
- For voice service, verify phone jack has a dial tone

Power down, then power back up

- Unplug power cord from modem/ Wi-Fi Gateway
- · Wait 15 seconds, then plug in
- · Make sure Power light comes on
- · Check Power button or try another outlet
- · Try to access Internet again
