

## How to Connect to the AT&T Mobile Broadband Network

Enjoy the power of AT&T's 4G mobile broadband network as soon as you turn on your Nexus 7; just follow these simple steps to get connected fast.

1. With the device off, insert the SIM provided if it has not been previously inserted. Detailed instructions can be found in the Nexus 7 Quick Start Guide inside the Nexus 7 box.
2. Turn on the device and complete the on-screen setup. This requires a Wi-Fi connection. You will see "Setup Complete" when you are finished with this step.
3. When you are ready to activate your AT&T mobile broadband service, or if your service has expired, either turn off Wi-Fi (Settings > Wi-Fi > *slide* On to Off) or move to a location outside of your Wi-Fi service area. You will need a debit card, credit card or an existing account to (re)activate service.
4. Your Nexus 7 will provide an indicator  on the left side of the notification bar at the top of your screen when Wi-Fi is not available and your AT&T mobile broadband service is ready to be (re)activated. If you do not receive a notification, open Google Chrome™ on your device or any PC, go to <https://buyasession.att.com> and proceed to step 4c:
  - a. Tap the indicator and drag down. You will see your list of notifications.
  - b. Tap "Sign into network" 
  - c. Google Chrome will open and present a secure AT&T Data-Connect tab. Select that tab and follow the prompts to purchase your preferred AT&T data plan. *If you are activating on an existing post-paid account, the primary cellular number for that account will be requested. If needed, the IMEI # can be found on the white label on the Nexus 7 box. The ICCID # is located on the AT&T SIM card holder.*

d. Once complete, you will receive a text message or e-mail confirming that your service has started.

5. IMPORTANT: If you turned off Wi-Fi in step #3, turn it back on (Settings > Wi-Fi > *slide* to On). AT&T mobile broadband network will be used whenever you are not connected to Wi-Fi.

## How to Manage Your Data Usage

To manage connections to the mobile network, touch Apps > Settings > Wireless Networks > Mobile Networks.

Check the estimated data usage by touching Apps > Settings > Data Usage or login to your AT&T account at <https://buyasession.att.com> via the Google Chrome browser (or from any PC).

**Note:** Actual billed usage can be higher than the estimated data usage displayed. For example, actual billed usage can be higher when you travel internationally or outside of the AT&T network, or when you use a SIM card with another device. On-device usage display is not a 1:1 reflection of actual AT&T data usage. Your data use is estimated by Google, not AT&T.
